Collaboration

We collaborate **across all sectors to promote the health of our communities**. We partner with local and national organizations to advance interprofessionalism and collaborative healthcare in Minnesota and beyond. We also work closely with health profession programs across system campuses to ensure that the interprofessional education curriculum is strategically integrated through a coordinated approach.

U of M IPE Curriculum

Our 1Health interprofessional education (IPE) curriculum is intentionally designed to provide students with relevant content and experiences aligned with progression through their respective professional program.

We prepare our health professions learners across 3 phases:

- Phase 1-Orientation to IPE
- Phase 2- Necessary Skills
- Phase 3- Expertise in Practice (Collaboration in Action)

The intent of 'Collaboration in Action' experiences is to engage students in the clinical learning environment through active, practice-based interprofessional activities. Current offerings are designed to place low-to-no burden on preceptors, with tremendous potential for partnered, community-level experience development in the future.

Learners complete one to five activities during clinical rotations and reflect on competency growth:

Collaboration in Action
Engage with Peer Allied Learners (PALs) from another profession
Finding your WHY in collaborative practice; Patient values in care
Observe & reflect on teamwork in action using a standardized tool
Consult with interprofessional learners on case-in-practice analysis
Conduct a community needs assessment
Practice & model interprofessional communication strategies
